

Cookie Policy

Definition

A cookie is a small file, typically of letters and numbers, downloaded on to a device when the user accesses certain websites. Cookies are then sent back to the originating website on each subsequent visit. Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognize a user's device without damage it. How are Cookies used?

Thai Name Server Co., Ltd. ("ThaiNS") use cookies on thains.co.th and nic.scb ("Website") to improve our service. Some cookies we use are essential for some services to work on our websites; others are used to collect usage information (statistics) so we can make the websites more convenient and useful.

ThaiNS use both session cookies and persistent cookies. A session cookie will expire at the end of the user session, when the web browser is closed. A persistent cookie consists of a text file sent by a web server to a web browser, which will be stored by the browser and remain valid until its set expiry date (unless deleted by the user before the expiry date). The below list details the cookies used in our websites.
